HELP UNIVERSITY AND HELP ACADEMY STUDY AWARDS

Since its establishment in 1986, HELP has awarded many study awards to encourage Malaysians and international students who demonstrate academic excellence and display leadership qualities to pursue their tertiary education at the university. Many of these recipients have completed their courses and have embarked on successful careers.

HELP welcomes both new and continuing students who are high achievers to apply for study awards.

FULL AND PARTIAL STUDY AWARDS

If you meet the minimum criteria stated, you are required to do the following:

1. Complete a HELP Study Awards Application Form and attach certified transcripts of your academic results.
2. New students are required to submit a HELP Application Form to apply for the chosen programme and pay the Student Application Fee before submitting the study award application form.
3. New students will submit the respective forms and attachments to the study award officer in the Registry before the specified deadline. Late applications will not be considered for selection.
4. For consideration by the study award committee in May and October of each year, study awards applicants must be registered students of HELP University or HELP Academy. Your form will be forwarded to the study award committee for consideration when the Committee meets in May and October.
5. The decisions of the study award committee will be announced by the third week of May and October and are not subject to appeal.

Important Notice:

1. As study awards are limited and competitive, only candidates who meet the minimum criteria specified in this brochure are eligible to apply for the study award committee's due consideration.
2. Meeting the minimum criteria does not automatically guarantee the applicant a study award.
3. All study awards applicants will be evaluated and short-listed by the Financial Aid Committee of HELP University / HELP Academy. HELP's study awards committee reserves the right to revise the criteria from time to time without prior notice. The decision of the Financial Aid Committee is final.
4. Students are only entitled to one study award at any one time. Study awards include prizes and fee waivers.
5. Applicants may be awarded a sum that may be less than what is stipulated in the brochure, depending on the availability of the study awards fund.
6. All study awards are awarded on a first come, first served basis.
7. Study awards may differ from intake to intake. Students are advised to submit their application before the stipulated deadline.

1. All Awards are issued subject to prevailing terms and conditions.
2. The Award is open to Malaysian and International students who completed the SPM/O Level exams taken in 2022/2023 ONLY.
3. Combined results from different exams periods will not be eligible for the Awards.
4. Students must obtain a minimum of 5 credits in the final SPM/O-Level examination to be eligible for the Programme. If this condition is not met, they will have to withdraw from the Programme and any fees paid will not be refundable.
5. Once the SPM/O Level results are released, ALL students MUST submit a copy of the results and the Certificate Award as soon as possible.
6. Students who apply for the A-Levels Study Award 2023 are not eligible to apply for any other Awards or Fee Waiver offered by HELP, e.g., SASA, Sibling Discount etc.
7. A non-refundable Programme Application Fee and Administrative Fee of RM3,100 must be paid before the Award application
8. The Study Award is given based on 4 subjects programme/tuition fee valued at RM35,000. If a subject is dropped during the course of study, no refund or adjustment of fees will be made. A subject can only be dropped after the first semester with the approval of the Head of A-Levels Department.
9. Certain categories of Awards (RM24K, RM22K, RM20K) are limited and are issued based on availability on a first come first serve basis for EACH category – consideration based only if the minimum payment of RM3,100 is received (non-refundable). For clarification, please check with the A Levels Department.
10. The grades A, A*, A+ accepted for subjects must be based on the list of subjects issued by the A-Levels Department for 2023. Subjects not included in this list will not be considered. A- will not be considered.
11. If the number of awards issued (for a category) for that intake has been used up, then the applicant may appeal for the Award (provided still open) in the next available intake (ie student must join the next available intake) or alternatively, apply for a lower quantum award (next category). Confirmation on this must be sought from the A Levels Department to ensure availability.
12. All other categories (RM17K, RM15K, RM12K and RM10K) are open without any limitations.
13. There will be NO Upgrading of Study Award upon receiving actual results for ALL categories. This means there will be no change in the award whether the subsequent actual results are better or worse than the previous Mock/Trial exam results.
14. Recipients of the Study Award must pay application, administration, resource, lab and external examination fees which are all non-refundable if they withdraw from the programme for whatever reason.
15. The duration of the Study Award is the duration of the Programme. The Study Award ends as soon as the Programme has been completed for the intake registered.
16. The Study Award is given on the understanding that the students will complete the full duration of the Programme. If they withdraw at any point before completing the Programme, the Award will be terminated and they will have to reimburse HELP Academy the full quantum of the Fee Waiver received to date.
17. All Awards will be disbursed in the form of Fee Waiver over 3 semesters of the Programme.
18. For international students, please ensure you have a valid Student Visa throughout the duration of the intended Programme. The Study Award is tied to the intake applied in 2023 and cannot be carried forward to a subsequent intake.
19. HELP Academy reserves the right to revise the terms and conditions of this Award without prior notice.

EXTERNAL STUDY AWARDS

THE UNIVERSITY OF QUEENSLAND GLOBAL CONNECT STUDY AWARDS

HELP University students commencing in an eligible University of Queensland (UQ) undergraduate programme via an articulation pathway will be eligible to receive the UQ Global Connect Study Awards.

This study award is applicable for the duration of their undergraduate programme at UQ and students will also receive a dedicated welcome session and networking sessions each semester, in addition to opportunities to engage in UQ's flagship entrepreneurship programmes through Ventures.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Students are allowed to switch awards only once, ie Bursary to study award or vice versa.
2. Students will be entitled to only one of the study awards or bursaries (whichever is higher) and students are not allowed to combine awards.
3. Applicants are required to pay all administration fees, course fees and external fees (if any) pending the decision of the study awards committee.
4. For new students who have not joined HELP, a minimum payment of the Student Application Fee is required before the student is eligible to apply for any study award. Otherwise, the study award application is considered null and void.
5. For students who have applied to join HELP for a chosen programme, he / she is expected to register during the intake date and is required to pay all administration fees, course fees and external fees (if any) by the last day of payment pending the decision of the study awards committee. Otherwise, the study award application is considered null and void.
6. The study award/bursary is not applicable for payment of re-sit / re-enrolment fees.
7. For programme where course fees are charged by the subject (modular programme), the total study award amount is divided equally among the total number of subjects and will go towards payment of course fees payable to HELP.
8. For programmes where course fees are charged by the year (linear programme), the total study award amount will go towards payment of course fees payable to HELP.
9. HELP reserves the right to revoke any study award / packaged bursary due to failure in examinations, unauthorized dropping of courses, withdrawal from programme before completion and / or non-compliance with HELP Rules and Regulations or other Terms & Conditions of the study award. Recipient may be required to repay the study award / bursary amount used upon revocation.
10. Recipients of the study awards who are subsequently found in breach of any of the rules and regulations, academic or otherwise, will have their study awards revoked and will be required to repay HELP the said sum of money.
11. All recipients of study awards are required to contribute 3-5 hours per week of their time to assist the Head of Department or their designate in administration, peer counselling, extra-curricular activities, marketing and promotional activities.
12. The study award application deadline is as below:
 - a) 2 weeks after commencement of programmes OR 2 weeks after the release of actual results.
 - b) The study awards committee will meet in mid-May and mid-October each year to shortlist candidates for the awards.
13. All decisions made by HELP University on matters pertaining to the study awards will be final. Only short-listed applicants will be notified.
14. The qualifications required for the study awards may vary from year to year. Applicants should check with the study awards officer on the requirements before applying.
15. Late and incomplete application forms will not be considered for selection.
