CRITERIA (CAT 1 and 2):

 - i. 30-hour Famine DIY Camp; or
 - ii. 8-Hour Kidz Famine DIY Camp; or
 - iii. 8-Hour Parent and Child Famine DIY Camp.
- b. Participation in the above can be in any of the following roles:
 - i. Camper;
 - ii. Camp leader;
 - iii. Camp Committee Member;
 - iv. Past Volunteers.

Additional Requirement :-

- **RM 20,000 Tuition Fee Waiver for Foundation / Diploma / Bachelor's Degree (Year 1)**
 - President of a Club / Society or School Prefect **or**

 - Obtain a minimum of 2 As (A+ / A / A-) in SPM / IGCSE for year 2024/2025/2026 with a total of 5 credits (For Foundation and Diploma). **or**
 - Obtain a minimum of 1A and 2 Bs (A+ / A / A-) in STPM / A-Levels or 5 As in UEC for year 2024/2025/2026 (*applicable to Non-HELP University Students and HELP University students*) **or**
 - Obtain a **CGPA of 3.50** in Foundation / Diploma Programme (*applicable to Non-HELP University Students and HELP University students*)

1. Application Form **MUST** be attached with the following documents (relevant & applicable)
 - i. Copy of NRIC (Front & Back)
 - ii. Academic Results / Transcripts / Certificates
 - iii. Co-curricular Certificates / Testimonies by School / Organisation
 - iv. Payment of **RM 300** Application Fee
2. Application Period: **From NOW to 31 December 2027** or till the fund fully redeemed.
3. Approval of the Study Award and amount is determined by a process including the meeting of the programme's academic entry requirements and an interview process.
4. Tuition Fee Waiver is **ONLY** applicable for **2025 to 2027** Intakes or when the fund is fully redeemed
5. Tuition Fee Waiver is non-transferable or not exchangeable for cash.
6. Tuition Fee Waiver is **NOT** applicable for deferment of Intake upon approval by the University & acceptance by student.
7. The university reserve the right to accept and reject the application where the decision of the university is final.
8. Applicants will be required to obtain a recommendation letter from World Vision via an interview process conducted by World Vision.
9. Applicants shortlisted by World Vision will need to undergo an interview process with the University.
