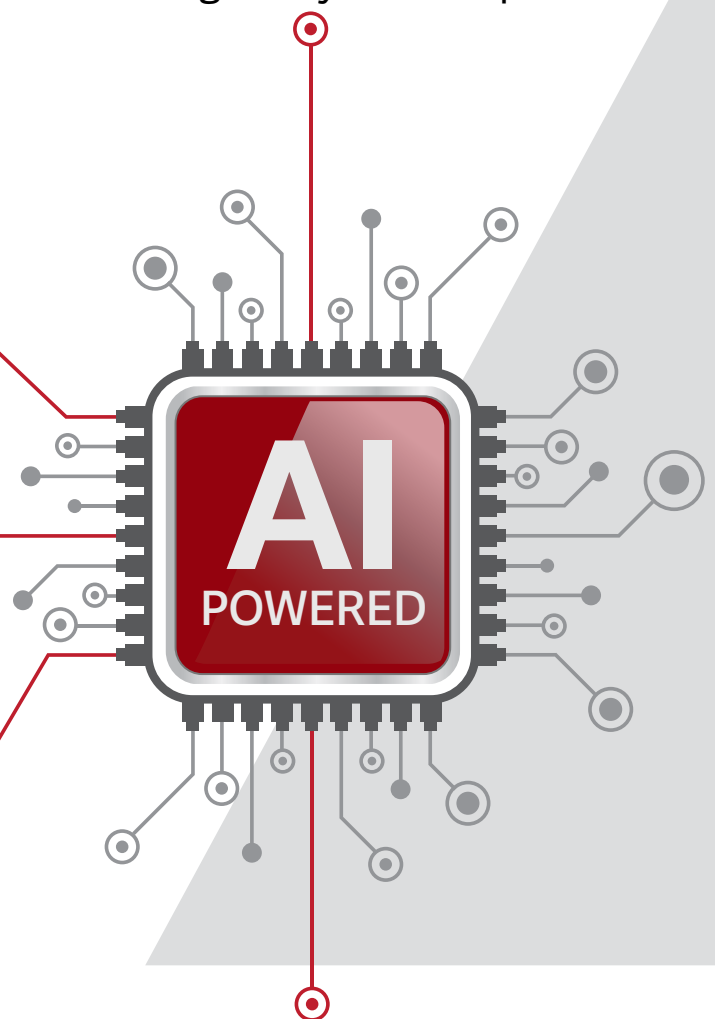

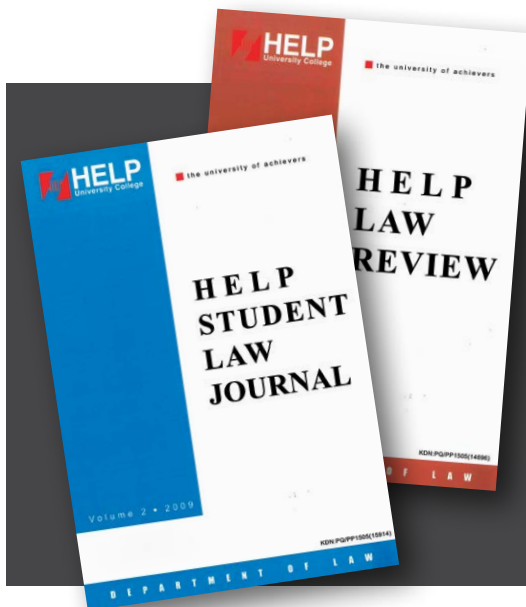

MOOT COURT @ HELP

The Moot Court is primarily used for practical assessments in skills-based courses for both the UKDTP and HULLB programmes. It facilitates assessments in areas such as mooting, bail applications, and interlocutory applications, where students are evaluated on their practical skills. These include preparing documentation, conducting research, and presenting submissions in a courtroom setting.

The Moot Court provides students with a realistic environment to develop these essential skills over time, helping them gain confidence and familiarity with courtroom proceedings.

Additionally, the Moot Court plays a role in the annual Law Olympiad, where participants witness a mock trial performed by staff and students from the Department, adding an engaging and educational dimension to the event.



RESEARCH AND PUBLICATIONS

These journals cover both traditional and cutting-edge topics, supporting undergraduate research for assignments and final-year dissertations.

- **The HELP Law Review:** A referred publication by the faculty that fosters legal writing and critical thinking among academics and legal professionals.
- **The HELP Student Law Journal:** A student-led publication by the faculty, with undergraduates managing the editing and writing of articles. Academic staff provide guidance, ensuring a valuable and enriching learning experience.



MENTORING AND TALKS BY GUEST LECTURES



The Faculty offers Professional Development Courses and Guest Lectures facilitated by distinguished legal practitioners, professors, and retired judges, including foreign judges, on current legal topics. These sessions provide students with valuable exposure to various areas of legal practice.



LAW CONFERENCE

The Tan Sri Dato' Seri Dr. Abdul Malek Law Students' Conference, established in 2018, provides a platform for undergraduate and postgraduate law students to present their research and engage in discussions on current legal issues.

Open to HELP University law students and others, the conference promotes academic exchange, collaboration, and professional development within an inclusive and dynamic setting.

LAW DINING

Conducted under the Event Management MPU subject, The Law Dining is inspired by the formal dinings of the UK Inns of Court. This event introduces students to the etiquettes of fine dining while providing an invaluable opportunity to network with alumni, academic staff, and invited guests.

A highlight of the event is the keynote speech delivered by a member of the Bench or a senior member of the Bar, offering students insights and experiences from esteemed legal professionals.

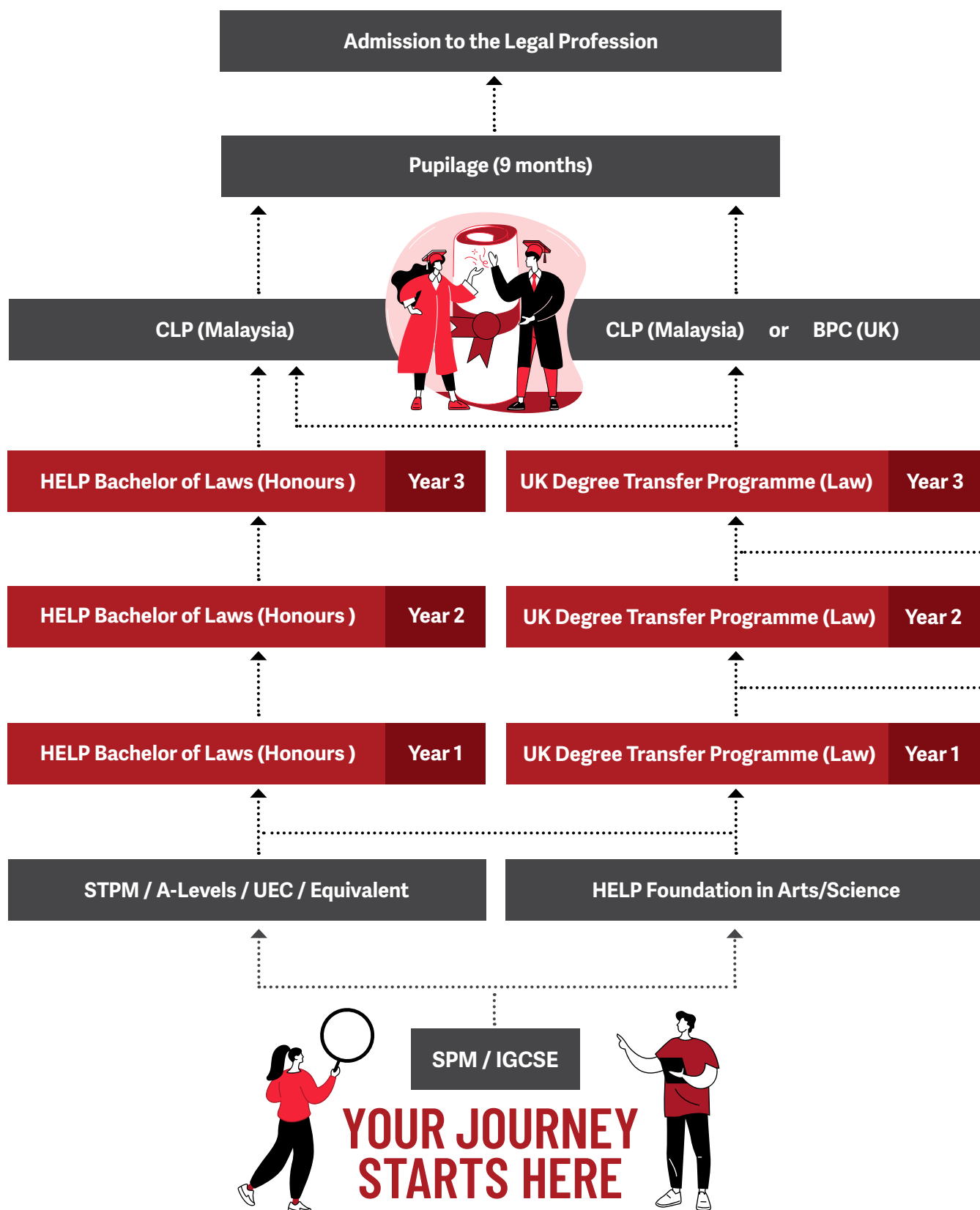

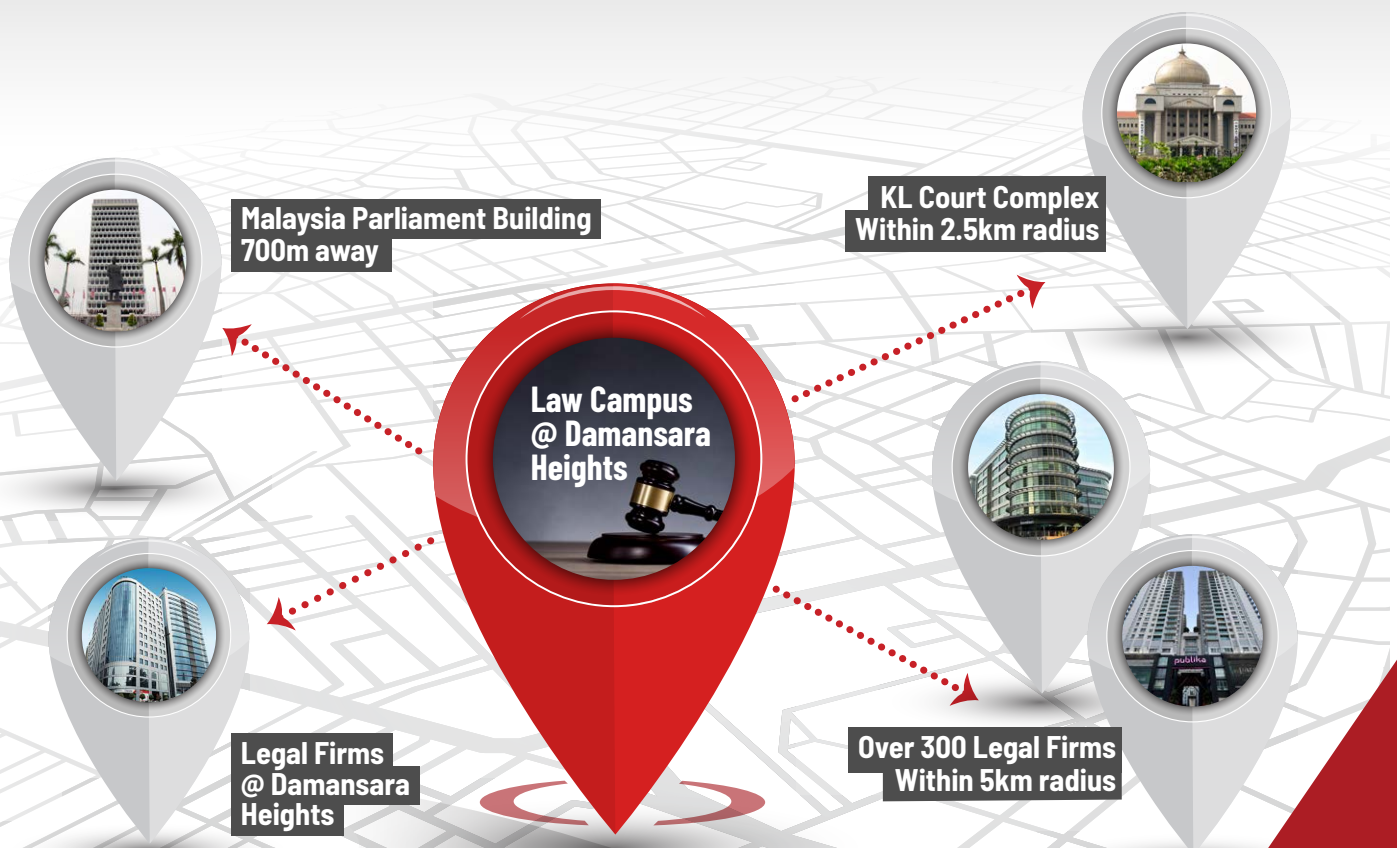

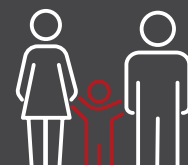
